JESUS DIES... COMES BACK TO LIFE



It was a terrible, painful way to die.

Beaten nearly to death, found guilty in a latenight trial, bullied by Roman soldiers.

Betrayed by friends. Pushed and shoved through crowded streets to a hill outside of Jerusalem and then nailed to a cross to hang as a warning to anyone else who might call himself a "King."

Torn. Bloody. Alone in ways no one else could begin to understand.

And then—darkness. Death. A cave covered by a heavy stone that sealed away Jesus' body from light, from life.

Peter and John were in Jerusalem and, as usual, in a hurry. The 3 o'clock prayer service at the Temple was starting soon, and they'd only made it as far as the Temple gate.

That's where they saw a lame beggar—one who'd been there day after day. The man asked Peter and John for money and was happy to see the two men pause.

But then Peter said something the beggar had never heard before. "Look, we don't have any money to give you," Peter said. "But I'll give you what I have. In the name of Jesus, stand up and walk."

Peter took the beggar's hand and pulled him up—and at once the beggar's withered legs were healed.

People nearby went nuts. Had they just seen this? INCREDIBLE!

Peter knew the men who'd killed Jesus were nearby. It was dangerous to draw attention, to stay there in the middle of a quickly growing crowd.

But God helped Peter be bold, so Peter raised a hand for quiet. "People, this wasn't us!" he shouted. "It was the power of Jesus—who you had killed. But God raised him from the dead and we know that to be true. What you just saw proves it!"

Peter boldly preached about Jesus even as he saw the Temple guards closing in, pushing through the crowd like wolves circling in for the kill.
