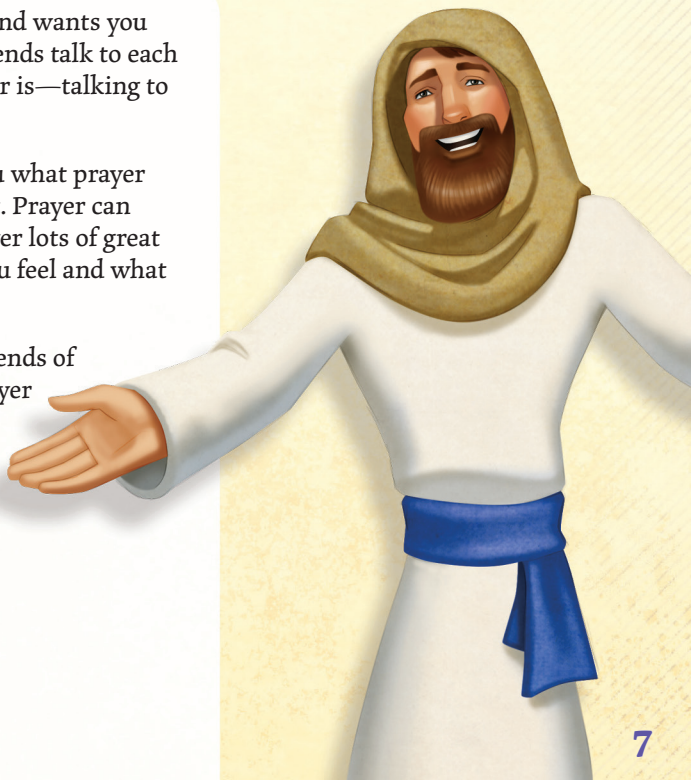
# LET'S TALK WITH GOD!


God loves you *so much* and wants you to be his friend. And friends talk to each other. That's what prayer is—talking to God, your friend.

*Psalms 17:6*

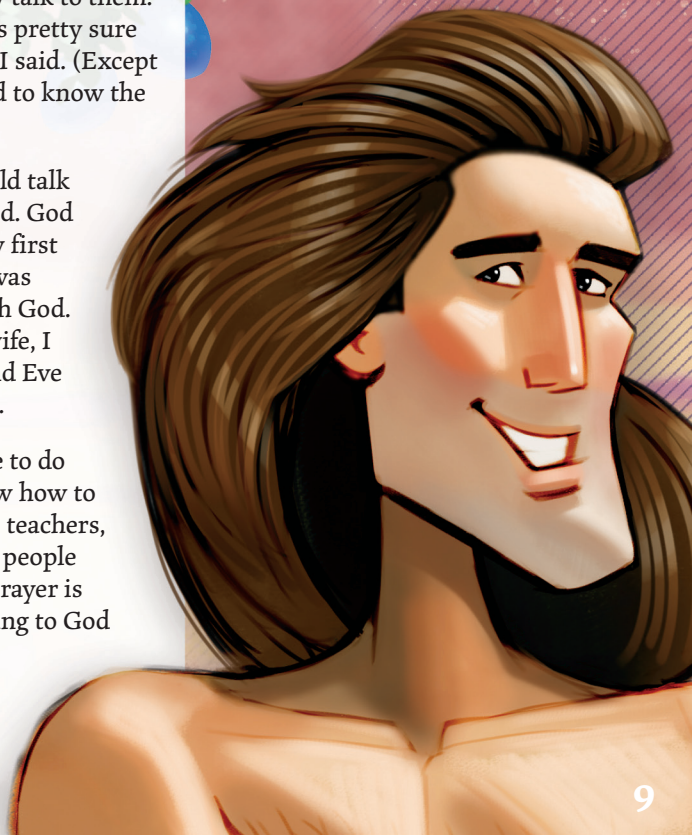


## ADAM

*Jeremiah 29:12*



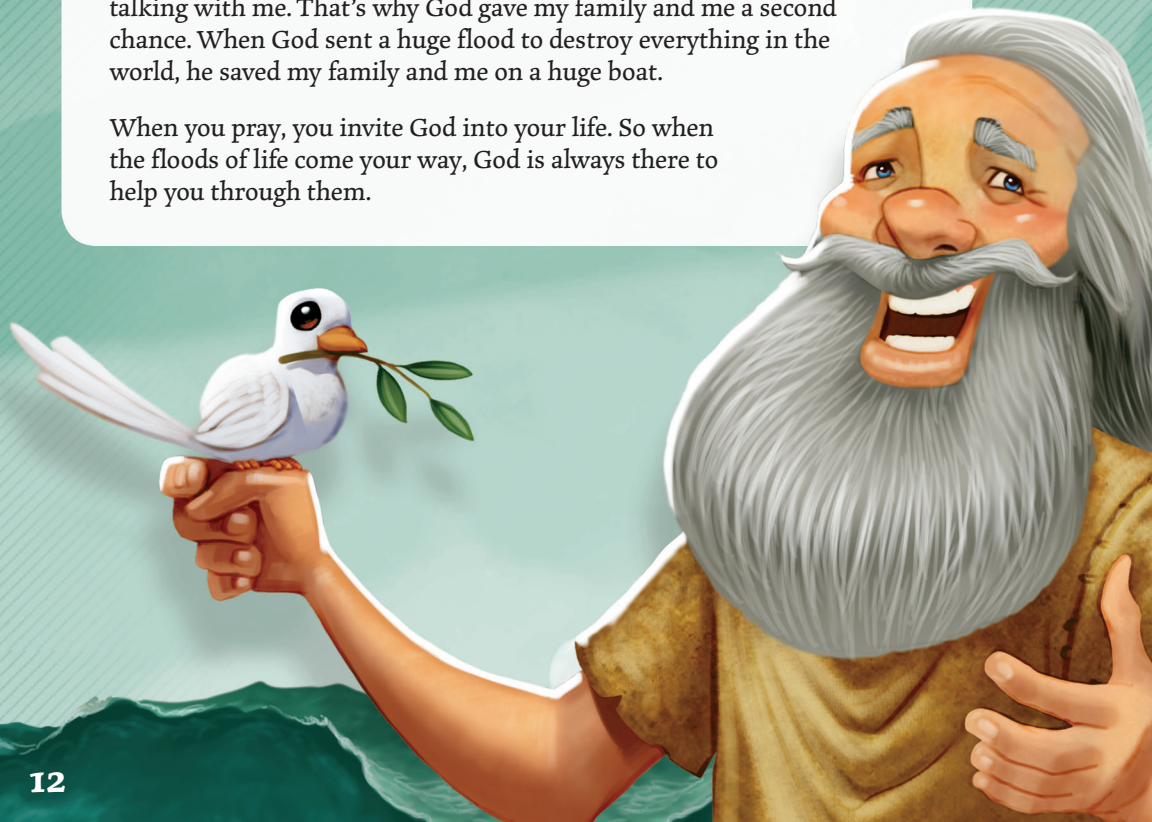


# NOAH
